Competition Classes and entry requirements:

The competition is open to individual and group entries from primary schools, secondary schools, home educators and community groups across the UK. There are three categories of entry – Individuals, Small Groups (up to 10 per group) or Large Groups (over 10 per group), plus two Classes for each category – Class 1 (ages 7-10) and Class 2 (ages 11-14).
